Note: For **AY 2023-2024** priority is given to first-time undergraduate and/or first-time graduate degree programs in Public Administration. All other applications pursuing degrees that are not Public Administration may be considered if there are available slots or during the next round of scholarship availability.

A total of 6 undergraduate and 6 graduate scholarships are available this application cycle.

You must complete all sections of the application form. Please do not leave any sections blank. If the section does not apply to you, please indicate with a "N/A" or "none."

LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION / FINANCIAL SUPPORT: All letters should be included in the application packet and be addressed to the Chair, Public Administration and Legal Studies at the address provided above: A letter of recommendation on your behalf must be submitted by any government, education, or community leader on Guam (preferably from leaders who have direct knowledge of your work and academic capabilities as an employee within the Government of Guam).

A letter of recommendation on your behalf must be submitted from your supervisor, department, or agency Director.

NOTE: You must submit a total of 2 letters of recommendation.

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ADDITIONAL LETTER FOR AUTONOMOUS AGENCY APPLICANTS

Per Public Law 19-45, as amended, autonomous agencies are required to pay for tuition/fees and books of any merit employee from their organization selected to participate in the program. A letter of recommendation of your behalf must be submitted from your autonomous agency supervisor/director indicating that the financial support of tuition/fees and books shall be covered by the agency.

NOTE: If you work for an Autonomous Agency, a total of 3 letters must be submitted.

TRANSCRIPTS AND EDUCATION INFORMATION:

The following documents must be included with your application packet, when applicable.

If you have received a high school diploma or General Equivalency Diploma and have no college or university credits, please submit: A copy of your high school diploma or GED.

If you have received college or university credits and have not attended UOG or have been admitted to UOG by the deadline of this application, please submit: Official transcripts from all college(s) and universities attended.

If you have graduated from a college or university other than the UOG, please submit: <u>All transcripts from the colleges</u> and universities you have attended. Transcripts must indicate the degree conferred.

If you are currently enrolled at UOG, you DO NOT need to include transcripts. You must sign the statement to release transcripts included in the application so the Scholarship committee can access and review your transcripts.

Note: Applicants must complete the UOG admissions process prior to scheduled Pedro "DOC" Sanchez interviews.

GOVERNMENT OF GUAM EMPLOYMENT STATUS:

Prior to commencing studies under the scholarship, applicants must be a career classified government of Guam employee with a minimum of two (2) years of classified service, beyond the probationary period. Applicants must be in good standing with a satisfactory performance rating.

A verification of employment, the form must include <u>job title</u>, <u>pay letter grade and step</u>, <u>time-frame of classified</u> <u>position</u>, <u>and type of job classification (i.e. unclassified, classified, temporary, etc.)</u>

A copy of your most recent performance evaluation must be submitted.

COMPLETED and received by the Sanchez Scholarship Program Coordinator on or before the deadline will be submitted to the Committee for selection to proceed to interviews. If you are selected for an interview we will notify you of the date, time, and location. You will be notified in writing of the Committee's decision on your application and interview. If approved, you will be required to attend a MANDATORY PRE-AWARD ORIENTATION prior to receiving the award benefits.
